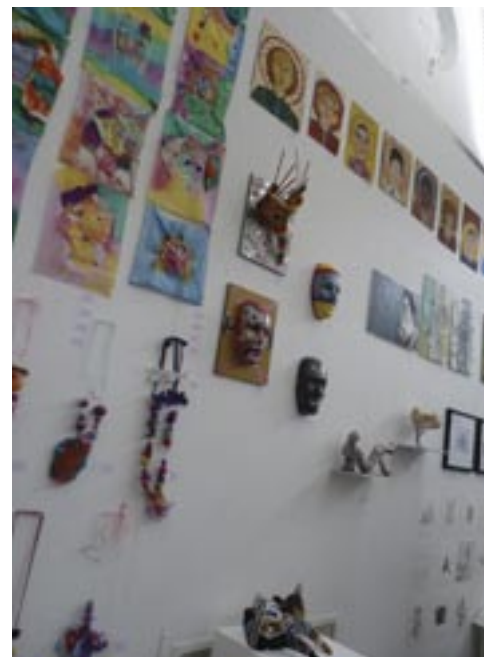
Kent welcomes Mandeville the Paralympic mascot...
